Dear Woodbury Democrats,

In November 2007, thanks to *your* efforts, and with strong support from unaffiliated voters and Republicans, we elected Paul Hinckley as Woodbury's First Selectman—only the 3rd time a Democrat has won this position in the last 100 years.
